The purpose of a winter tournament competition is to introduce new students to practice showing; as well as, to keep seasoned students practiced for the upcoming show season. While many riders will be of the academy level this is NOT to be considered an academy competition. **RIDERS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO CROSS ENTER FROM LEVEL TO LEVEL.** Show attire is not permitted! Neatly fitted jods, boots, and shirts are recommended. For obvious reasons well fitted outdoor wear is permitted. Logo wear is acceptable. **HELMETS ARE REQUIRED FOR ALL RIDERS 17 YEARS OF AGE OR YOUNGER. SAFETY IS PARAMOUNT!** **ANY HORSE OR RIDER DEEMED TO BE HARMFUL TO THEMSELVES OR OTHERS WILL BE EXCUSED FROM COMPETITION IMMEDIATELY.**

**EQUIPMENT** – Saddles of the cut back type are to be used in regular classes. Forward/hunt seat saddles are to be used in hunt seat classes. English bridles of the snaffle or full type are to be used. Running and German martingales are allowed. If using any type of leverage bit (curb, Pelham, kimberwick or any bit that uses a curb chain/strap) the curb rein **MUST NOT** be run through the martingale. Draw lines are acceptable as long as they are NOT used with a leverage type bit. The use of polos wraps are PROHIBITED! Splint boots are permissible.

**HORSES**-Horses are to be those that are used on a routine basis in a **PROFESSIONALY** conducted riding program. Show horses are allowed **ONLY** in show practice classes.

### **Class descriptions-**

**ADVANCED**- For riders of show or elite status. This will not affect the return to show rider or elite academy classes.

**INTERMEDIATE**- For riders beyond their first year of competition but have not reached show or elite status.

**BEGINNER**- For riders starting their **FIRST** year of competition. **SHOW**

**PRACTICE**- For riders on show type or academy type horses. The purpose is for any rider of advanced or intermediate level to practice showmanship/horsemanship.

**PATTERN CLASS**-Pattern only. Tests 1-15 or a combination can be used at the judge's discretion for WTC. Patterns suitable for WT riders can be used at the judge's discretion. Patterns will be available before the tournament. These classes are open to any level rider.

**COMMAND**- Class designed for **beginner to intermediate** level. Simple commands may include, circles, halting on the rail, extension of the trot, etc. No riders in these classes are to be asked to drop stirrup irons.

**EXCEPTIONAL**-Open to English equitation riders with a physical or mental handicap, riding a mare or gelding.

Classes will be split when necessary. Beginner classes will not have more than 6 entries. You are **STRONGLY** urged to classify your riders when submitting entries. This will aid in the splitting of classes if necessary.
